

Guild Outreach Committee

Committee Description: This committee aims to foster community, connection, information, and resource sharing among the grassroots networks of Guild and Guild affiliates who provide regional support for cheesemakers.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- What does the committee work on? It meets every-other-month throughout the year for peer-to-peer learning and discussion. Each meeting discussion focuses on one topic, and topics are voted on and ranked by committee members. Topics covered over the past two years included:
 - Guild Membership and benefits
 - Revenue streams
 - A deep dive into how guilds bring value to cheesemakers
 - Creating educational opportunities for guild members
 - Leadership: sharing wins and getting help
 - Agritourism initiatives
 - Sponsorship strategies
 - Board recruitment and engagement
 - Building a Strategic Marketing Plan
 - Event features beyond the festival: tokens, goodie bags, guided tastings
- What tasks do you complete each year? We host round table, deep dive, and guest speaker discussions, focused on topics to help support and develop cheese guilds
- Is any travel required? No travel is required; with the exception of meeting in person annually at the ACS conference, all our meetings are virtual.

Time Commitment:

- What months are busiest? Evenly split throughout the year
- How many hours are generally expected of a committee member each month? Typically we have a 1.5 hour meeting every other month
- How long are members expected to participate on the committee? Ongoing while serving as a regional guild leader

Desired Skills:

• Are there any skills that are required? Committee Members should be leaders of regional cheese guilds or looking to start a cheese guild

Current Meeting Schedule:

- The committee currently meets every other month, usually the last Wednesday of the month 4-5:30pm EST
